- Complete the Venn Diagram provided and compare the different characteristics of the protagonist and antagonist. Avoid including physical features.

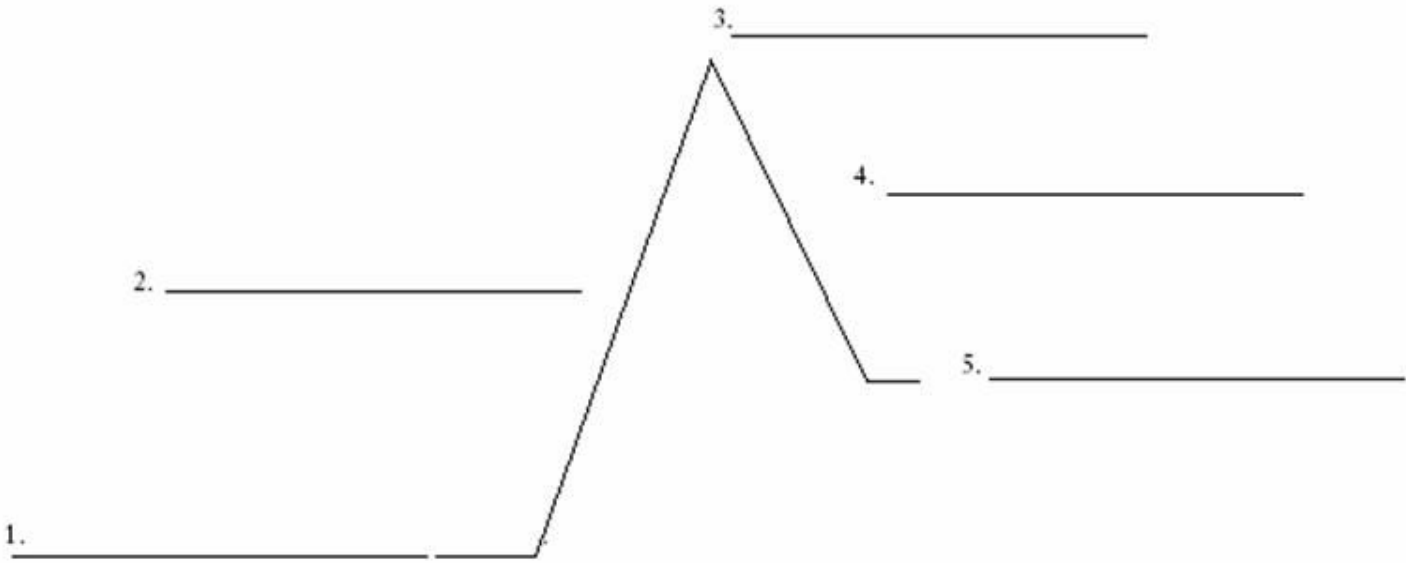
Alternate Ending (10 Marks)
